

- The CDC's Bridge Access Program offers free COVID-19 vaccines to uninsured adults and those with insurance that doesn't cover all vaccine costs. Over 20,000 retail pharmacies are part of this program.
- Additionally, vaccines are provided at safety-net and public health providers, which can include HRSA-supported health
 centers and other vaccine providers. All participating providers must update <u>vaccines.gov</u> with vaccine availability
 information, which is expected to increase in the near future.
