CDC Bridge Access Program

- The CDC's Bridge Access Program offers free COVID-19 vaccines to uninsured adults and those with insurance that doesn't cover all vaccine costs. Over 20,000 retail pharmacies are part of this program.
- Additionally, vaccines are provided at safety-net and public health providers, which can include HRSA-supported health centers and other vaccine providers. All participating providers must update vaccines.gov with vaccine availability information, which is expected to increase in the near future.



NHMA Flu Nudge Campaign

- This month, NHMA finalized an agreement with Western Health Advantage and Health Plan Alliance to deliver culturally competent, bilingual, physical mailers to Latine families in Sacramento, CA to remind them to schedule their influenza vaccinations.
